Your tasks might include:

- Pursuing strategic relationships with suppliers and general public to receive a continuous influx of material, labor and service donations (ex: siding, subcontractor labor, free dumpster services as gifts-in-kind).
- Finding and validating quality, dependable subcontractors and meeting subcontractors on site to obtain detailed written quotes.
- Ordering and stocking GIK to maximize savings for affiliate.
- Working with Construction team to coordinate delivery and storage of GIK materials.
- Developing detailed project cost estimates to be used for grant writing, accounting controls and budgeting.
