# Act now to protect North Carolinians affected by Hurricane Helene from evictions and foreclosures

A critical need in the near term for survivors of Hurricane Helene, renters and homeowners alike, is to keep people housed.

Send a message to Governor Cooper to immediately enact <u>at least a 90-day moratorium on evictions and foreclosures</u> in North Carolina.

Last week, the NC Inclusive Disaster Recovery Network, representing 300 organizations across the state, <u>submitted a letter</u> to Governor Cooper to use his executive powers to enact a moratorium. Join the call to protect our neighbors in Western NC by sending a message to Governor Cooper today!

## Talking points for your message:

- NC experienced such moratoria during COVID-19 and the practices established can be replicated to stabilize housing in Western NC in this moment.
- Preventing eviction and foreclosure can provide the housing stability that people need to reduce mental stress, stay connected to community supports and meet immediate needs for food and water.
- Evidence shows that <u>evictions increase in the year following a natural disaster</u>, especially in areas where residents have high housing cost burdens.
- Renters have no protection from evictions in the wake of a disaster in North Carolina.
  Landlords are legally allowed to demand rent even in the case of a disaster like Hurricane Helene.
