**What we've
accomplished**

In 40 years, we have:

1. Built more than 962 new homes.
2. Repaired 608 homes.
3. Served 987 families globally in Malawi, Cambodia and Honduras through our tithe.
4. Built in 17 local municipalities in Wake and Johnston counties.
5. Opened and operated 10 local Habitat ReStores.
6. Served an additional 2,630 households through our recent advocacy wins such as passing the \$80M Raleigh Housing Bond, allocating American Rescue Plan funding for affordable housing, and a host of local municipal actions.

do more**

Housing costs have outpaced incomes

15%



118%



Home prices have outpaced incomes since 1965.

The median home price in Wake County has risen by over 25% since January 2020.

**1 in 4 families is
cost burdened**

Cost-burdened = **Paying more than 30% of your
income towards housing**

That means choosing between:

- 1. Paying for housing**
- 2. Paying for groceries, school, medical bills,
bus fare or gas, healthcare.**



When people can afford a place to live

1. Children perform better in school and are more likely to go to college.
2. Residents have more financial security.
3. Neighborhoods are more cohesive and stable, leading to less crime.
4. Tax revenue and property values increase.
5. Employers see less turnover.

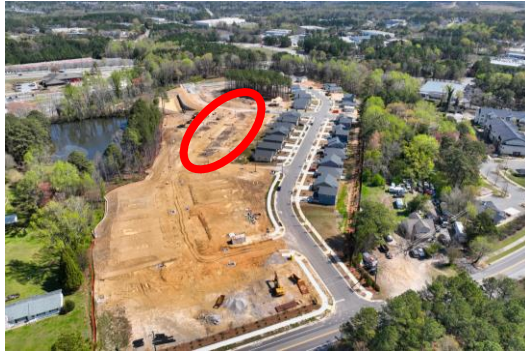

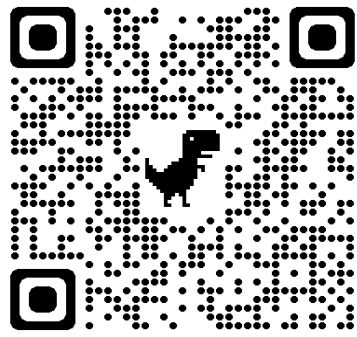

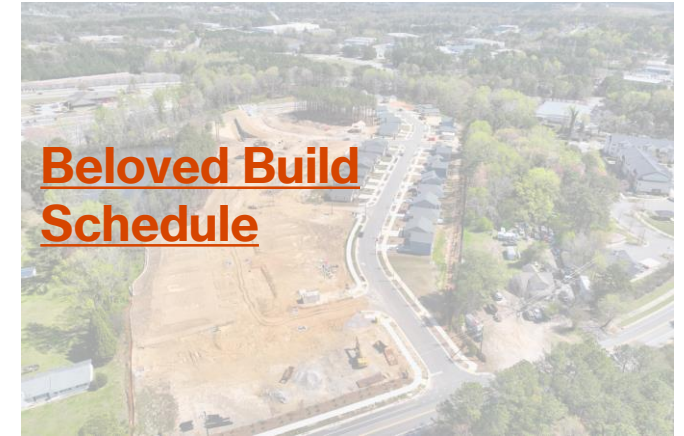

Step one

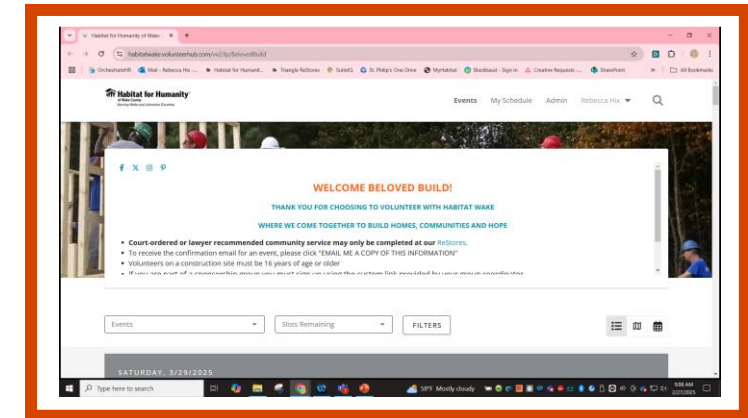
- Check the build schedule to determine which day you want to reserve.

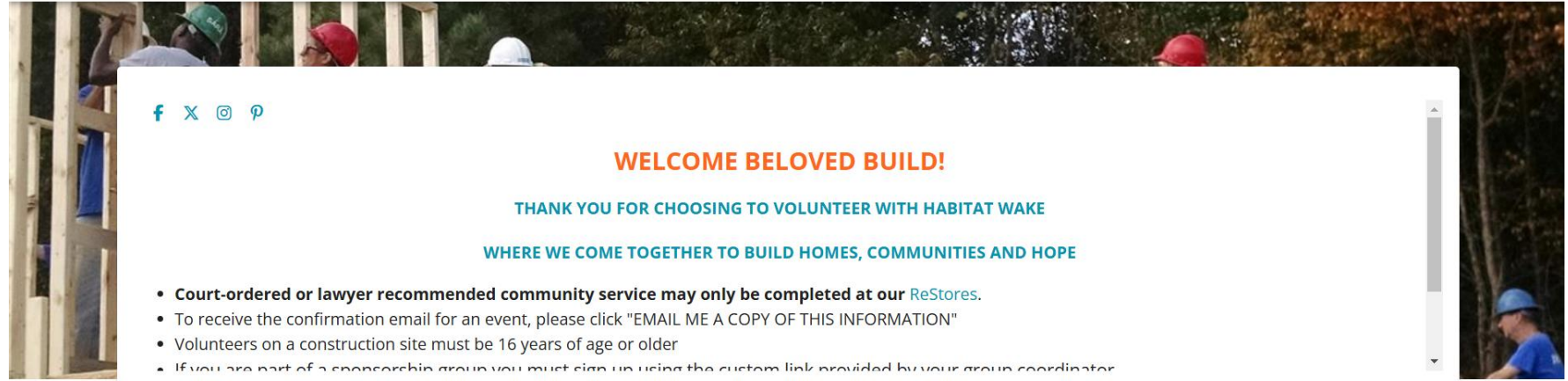
