


What we've accomplished



In 40 years, we have:

- 1. Built more than 950 new homes.
- 2. Repaired nearly 600 homes.



- 3. Helped fund and build nearly 1,000 homes globally in Malawi, Cambodia and Honduras.
- 4. Built in 17 local municipalities in Wake and Johnston counties.
- 5. Opened and operated 10 local Habitat ReStores.
- 6. Through advocacy efforts we are putting "shelter on hearts and minds in such powerful ways that the lack of affordable housing becomes socially, politically and religiously unacceptable."
 - Passing \$80M Raleigh Housing Bond, mobilizing to attend municipal hearings







1 in **4** families in our community are cost-burdened.




Cost-burdened = paying more than 30% of income towards housing.



That means choosing between:

- 1. Paying for housing
- 2. Paying for groceries, school, medical bills, bus fare or gas, healthcare.





When people can afford a place to live:

- 1. Children perform better in school and are more likely to go to college.
- 2. Residents have more financial security.
- 3. Neighborhoods are more cohesive and stable, leading to less crime.
- 4. Tax revenue and property values increase.
- 5. Employers see less turnover.

Build Families To **qualify** for a Habitat Home, you must be able to say **yes** to these questions:

- Have you lived or worked in Wake or Johnston County for the past 12 months?
- Do you have a valid Social Security Number?
- □ Have you maintained a steady income for the past 24 months?
- □ Are you a U.S. citizen or permanent resident?
- Do you have reasonably good credit?
- Do you have a good rental history?






